

Global Studies-Expectations Sheet

Homework

- * All homework will be turned in at the beginning of class on the day it is due.
- * Students who do not turn in their homework on the day it is due will receive a 10% reduction of the grade for every school day that it is late. It is the student's responsibility to make sure back work is completed.

Format

- * All homework will be typed, double-spaced unless other arrangements are made with the teacher OR if the assignment calls for handwriting
- * A 'page' will consist of 250-300 words.
- * Only papers typed in Times New Roman 12-point font will be accepted.
- * Margins will be one inch on every side.
- * *Neatness* – All assignments are expected to be neat, organized and pleasing to the eye. Work that is too messy will not be accepted.

Notebook

- * All students will need a three-ring binder dedicated to Global Studies
- * Only loose-leaf paper will be accepted; NO spiral-bound notebook paper
- * There will be frequent notebook checks throughout the year
- * Notebooks will need the following sections at all times throughout the year:
 - *Writing*
 - *Handouts* – things the teacher gives you, including reading assignments
 - *Notes* – things you write down throughout the year
 - *Maps*

Assignment book

- * You will need to bring an assignment book and have it out at the start of each class in order to receive credit for that day.

Website use

- * Students will be expected to visit and use my website on a weekly basis. In order to access this site from school you will need to submit and adhere to your Acceptable Use Policy (AUP). The school and town library both provide free Internet access. You will need to budget your time to use these resources if you do not have Internet access at home. I will post all classroom materials, calendars, assignments, pictures, music, etc. Starting in October you will also be required to take some quizzes online. Your first assignment is already posted there.
